## KURZINHALT

Die goldene Regel lautet: Vermische niemals Berufliches mit Privatem. Kein Problem für die knallharte Undercover-CIA-Agentin Sam (Rebel Wilson)! ## CAST BIOGRAPHIES

### REBEL WILSON (SAM)

Rebel Wilson is an Australian actress, writer and producer. She has a Bachelor of Laws / Bachelor of Arts (Theater and Film) double degree from the University of New South Wales. Rebel's career started on the Sydney stages where she often wrote and produced her own work. This led to various television shows in Australia where she quickly became the most prominent female voice in Australian comedy. In 2010 Rebel moved to the US with her role in the cult classic BRIDESMAIDS. Rebel is perhaps most known internationally for playing the role of FAT AMY in the PITCH PERFECT trilogy, which are the highest grossing musical comedy films of all time. Rebel's other feature credits include the Academy Award winning JOJO RABBIT, ISN'T IT ROMANTIC, HOW TO BE SINGLE, and THE HUSTLE. In 2022 she starred in the hit cheerleading comedy SENIOR YEAR and THE ALMOND AND THE SEAHORSE with Charlotte Gainsbourg based on the West End stage play.

### ANNA CAMP (BETSY)

Anna Camp is a celebrated actress and creative talent known for her versatility across television, film, and stage, delivering memorable performances in both comedic and dramatic roles.

Camp will soon be seen co-starring in Peacock's highly anticipated thriller, HYSTERIA!, opposite Julie Bowen. The series follows a high school metal band that exploits their town's "Satanic Panic" when a varsity quarterback goes missing. Camp plays a Midwestern mother and devout Christian who becomes an unlikely yet powerful town leader. The ensemble cast includes Bruce Campbell, Garret Dillahunt, Nikki Hahn, Emjay Anthony, Chiara Aurelia, and Kenzie Curtis.

HYSTERIA! is set to premiere on October 18, 2024.

Recently, Camp wrapped production on the fifth and final season of Netflix's thriller series, YOU, where she will portray twin sisters-in-law to Penn Badgley's anti-hero. She is also reuniting with Rebel Wilson in the much-anticipated action-comedy BRIDE HARD.

In June 2024, Camp appeared opposite Justin Bartha in the comedy NUKED, which premiered at the Tribeca Film Festival. Earlier in the year, she starred in the short film NEO-DOME, which premiered at SXSW and won the Audience Award for the "Independent TV Pilot Competition."

In April 2023, Camp both starred in and executive produced the AMC/Shudder horror film FROM BLACK.

One of Camp's most iconic roles is 'Aubrey,' the leader of the Barden Bellas, in Universal Studios' smash-hit PITCH PERFECT trilogy. The films became a global phenomenon, celebrated for their blend of comedy, music, and uplifting themes of friendship and empowerment, firmly establishing Camp's place in pop culture. Her performance added humor, depth, and charm to the franchise, contributing significantly to its critical acclaim and box office success.

In 2022, Camp starred alongside Bryan Cranston and Annette Bening in the Paramount+ comedy JERRY & MARGE GO LARGE and appeared in Sony Pictures' 5,000 BLANKETS. Other notable films include Sundance favorite A LITTLE PRAYER with Jane Levy and David Strathairn, Paramount's THE LOVEBIRDS with Kumail Nanjiani and Issa Rae, and the western MURDER AT YELLOWSTONE CITY with Gabriel Byrne and Richard Dreyfuss. Camp's additional film credits include GOODBYE TO ALL THAT, Netflix's DESPERADOS, Woody Allen's CAFE SOCIETY, the indie drama HERE AWHILE, UNEXPECTED (produced by Patricia Heaton), and the Academy Award-nominated THE HELP.

On television, Camp is recognized for starring in Amazon's critically acclaimed drama GOOD GIRLS REVOLT and NBC's comedy PERFECT HARMONY alongside Bradley Whitford. She is also known for her roles as 'Deirdre Robespierre' in Netflix's UNBREAKABLE KIMMY SCHMIDT, created by Tina Fey, and 'Sarah Newlin' on HBO's TRUE BLOOD. Other television appearances include NBC's THE OFFICE, major recurring roles on AMC's MAD MEN and CBS's THE GOOD WIFE, as well as guest spots on Fox's GLEE and CBS's HOW I MET YOUR MOTHER.

On stage, Camp has made her mark on Broadway, starring opposite Daniel Radcliffe in the 2008 revival of EQUUS and in Mike Nichols' THE COUNTRY GIRL with Morgan Freeman and Frances McDormand. Her Off-Broadway work includes ALL NEW PEOPLE, earning a Drama Desk Award nomination, THE SCENE with Patricia Heaton and Tony Shalhoub, which garnered a Lucille Lortel Award nomination, and VERITE at LCT3 Lincoln Center. Most recently, she performed in 2:22: A GHOST STORY with Constance Wu and Finn Wittrock at the Ahmanson Theatre in LA, and BELLEVILLE with Thomas Sadoski at the Pasadena Playhouse.

A native of South Carolina, Anna Camp currently splits her time between Los Angeles and Palm Springs.

## ANNA CHLUMSKY (VIRGINIA)

Anna Chlumsky is an Emmy nominated actress who has continued to make a name for herself in film, on television and on stage. In 2022, Chlumsky starred alongside Kevin Bacon, Carrie Preston and Theo Germain in John Logan's Blumhouse horror, "They/Them". The film was about a group of teenagers at an LGBTQ+ conversion camp that endure unsettling psychological techniques while being stalked by a mysterious masked killer. In February of the same year, she starred in the highly anticipated Shondaland/Netflix limited series "Inventing Anna." The series is based on the New York Magazine article "How Anna Delvey Tricked New York's Party People" by Jessica Pressler. Chlumsky took on the role Vivian Kent, who was based on Pressler, and co-starred alongside Julia Garner. In 2019, Chlumsky was nominated for her sixth consecutive Emmy in the category of Best Supporting Actress in a Comedy Series for her portrayal as 'Amy Brookheimer' in the HBO series, "Veep," which premiered for its seventh and final season in March 2019. She was also nominated for a Critics Choice Award and won a SAG Award with the cast in the category of Outstanding Performance by an Ensemble in a Comedy Series. Chlumsky has also won the Gracie Allen Award in 2015 for Outstanding Female Actor in a Supporting Role in a Comedy or Musical for her work in the series. Chlumsky was last seen in "Hala," which was acquired by Apple out of Sundance. The drama, directed by Minhal

Baig, follows a high school senior, Hala, who struggles to balance being a suburban teenager in Chicago with her family's strict upbringing. Chlumsky became a household name when she starred alongside Macaulay Culkin as 'Vada Sultenfuss' in the 1991 film, "My Girl." Other notable film credits include: "The End of Tour," "Bert and Arnie's Guide to Friendship," "In The Loop," "The Good Guy," "Blood Car," "My Girl 2," "Gold Diggers" "The Glamour Reel Short," and "Wait." Chlumsky made her Broadway debut in 2015 in Scott Ellis' revival of "You Can't Take It With You." She played 'Alice Sycamore,' the daughter of an eccentric family, opposite James Earl Jones and Annaleigh Ashford. She also reprised her role as 'Iris Peabody' in Joe DiPietro's "Living on Love," which made its Williamstown Theatre Festival debut in 2014 and transferred to Broadway. Based on the famed Peccadillo, Chlumsky starred opposite Renee Fleming, Douglas Sills and Jerry O'Connell. Additional New York stage credits include: "Cardinal," "3C," "Love, Loss, and What I Wore" (Westside Theatre); "So Help Me God" (Mint Theatre Company); "Unconditional" (LA Byrinth Theater Company); "The Fabulous Life of a Size Zero" (DR2); "Darwin in Malibu" (Bay Street Theatre); "The Butcherhouse Chronicles" (Summer Play Festival); "Balm in Gilead" (Barefoot Theater Company - Member); "Half Life" (Flea Theater/Fringe Festival); "Iphigeneia at Aulis" (TimeSpace Productions); "Measure for Measure" (Astoria Performing Arts Center); "No Alarms: Headfullofradio" (Veritas Productions); and "The Trojan Women" (Veritas Productions). Additional TV credits include AMC's "Halt and Catch Fire," NBC's "Hannibal," "30 Rock" and "Law & Order SVU." Anna currently resides in New York.

## DA'VINE JOY RANDOLPH (LYDIA)

Da'Vine Joy Randolph is an Academy Award-winning and Tony Award-nominated actress, known for captivating, emotionally tinged performances full of dignity. She seized the industry's attention with her scene-stealing role opposite Eddie Murphy in Netflix's DOLEMITE IS MY NAME. The film premiered at the 2019 Toronto Film Festival and subsequently premiered on Netflix globally on October 25, 2019. Da'Vine's breakthrough performance as the iconic "Lady Reed" in a star-studded feature earned her an NAACP Image Award nomination in the category of 'Best Supporting Actress in a Motion Picture.'

Most recently, Randolph began production for Universal Pictures' musical film ATLANTIS from director Michel Gondry and producer Pharrell Williams. The film, written by Martin Hynes and Steven Levenson, is inspired by Pharrell Williams' childhood in Virginia Beach.

Earlier this year, Randolph wrapped production for the upcoming action-comedy film, BRIDE HARD, directed by Simon West and written by Shaina Steinberg. Randolph also wrapped production for Lionsgate Films' action thriller, SHADOW FORCE, in which she will star alongside Kerry Washington, Omar Sy, and Cliff "Method Man" Smith. Additionally, Randolph will be seen reprising her role as "Detective Williams" alongside Steven Martin, Martin Short, Selena Gomez, and Meryl Streep in the fourth season of ONLY MURDERS IN THE BUILDING, which will premiere in 2024, on Hulu.

In 2023, Randolph starred in the comedy-drama film, THE HOLDOVERS, alongside Paul Giamatti and Dominic Sessa. The film, written by David Hemingson and directed by Alexander Payne, follows "Professor Hunham" (Giamatti), who finds himself stuck at a private boarding school over the holidays with troubled student, "Angus Tully" (Sessa), and the school's head cook, "Mary Lamb" (Randolph). Over two snowy weeks of Christmas break, the trio forms an unexpected bond and goes on a life changing journey together. The film was released in theaters by Focus Features on November 10, 2023.

On behalf of her performance in the film, Randolph received an Academy Award in the category of 'Best Supporting Actress.' She also received the following awards on behalf of her performance: 2024 Golden Globe Award, 2024 Screen Actors Guild Award, 2024 Film Independent Spirit Award, 2024 Critics' Choice Film Award, 2024 BAFTA Film Award, 2024 Astra Film & Creative Arts Award, 2024 Black Reel Award, and a 2024 Satellite Award, among others. Additionally, Randolph was honored with the Breakthrough Performance Award at the Palm Springs International Film Festival and was one of the honorees of the Virtuoso Award at the Santa Barbara International Film Festival in early 2024. She was also awarded with a 2023 New York Film Critics Circle Award and a 2023 National Board of Review Award for her performance.

Additionally, in 2023, Randolph was seen in the Netflix biographical drama, RUSTIN, starring Colman Domingo and Chris Rock. The screenplay, written by Julian Breece and Dustin Lance Black, was based on a story written by Breece about the life of civil rights activist Bayard Rustin. The film was directed by George C. Wolfe and produced by Barack and Michelle Obama's production company, Higher Ground. It premiered at the Telluride Film Festival on August 31, 2023. Also in 2023, Randolph portrayed the talent manager "Destiny" in HBO's THE IDOL, alongside The Weeknd and Lily-Rose Depp.

In 2022, Randolph was seen in Paramount Players' adaptation of Angie Thomas' New York Times bestseller, ON THE COME UP, opposite Method Man and Mike Epps. The film premiered at the Toronto International Film Festival on September 23, 2022. Additionally, Randolph appeared in Aaron & Adam Nee's comedy, THE LOST CITY, alongside Sandra Bullock, Channing Tatum, and Daniel Radcliffe. The romantic adventure was released in theaters by Paramount Pictures on March 25, 2022.

In 2021, Randolph appeared in Netflix's THE GUILTY, alongside Jake Gyllenhaal and Ethan Hawke. The film, which had its world premiere at the 2021 Toronto International Film Festival, was streamed in 69 million households over its first month of release and was the top-watched film on the platform in over 91 countries. 2021 continued to be a powerhouse year for Randolph as she also appeared in Hulu's critically acclaimed original series, ONLY MURDERS IN THE BUILDING, alongside Selena Gomez and comedic giants Martin Short and Steve Martin, as well as closing out the final season of TBS' beloved comedy series, THE LAST OG, opposite Tracy Morgan who also executive produced the series alongside Jordan Peele.

Previously in 2020, Randolph appeared in Lee Daniel's UNITED STATES VS BILLIE HOLIDAY with Natasha Lyonne, Andra Day, and Trevante Rhondes, which became the most-watched title on Hulu over its first three days of release. Randolph also starred opposite Zoë Kravitz in the ABC Studios/Hulu dramedy, HIGH FIDELITY, to glowing reviews.

That same year, Randolph was seen alongside Evan Rachel Wood in Miranda July's KAJILLIONAIRE for Annapurna and Plan B., as well as Andrew Cohn's THE LAST SHIFT. Both films premiered at the 2020 Sundance Film Festival and were immediately acquired by Focus Features/Universal Pictures and Sony Pictures Releasing, respectively.

Other illustrious film and television credits include Showtime's ON BECOMING A GOD IN CENTRAL FLORIDA, PEOPLE ON EARTH, EMPIRE, OFFICE CHRISTMAS PARTY, SELFIE, THIS IS US, LIFE IN PIECES, THE ANGRICEST MAN IN BROOKLYN, MOTHER OF GEORGE, THE GOOD WIFE, and ULTRA CITY SMITHS.

On stage, Da'Vine was nominated for a Tony Award for 'Best Performance by an Actress in a Featured Role' in GHOST, which impressively marked her West End and Broadway debuts. Randolph's career on stage continued to flourish and she went on to star opposite Chris Bauer in the critically acclaimed play, WHAT RHYMES WITH AMERICA, at the Atlantic Theatre Company, for which she was nominated for a Lucille Lortel Award for 'Outstanding Featured Actress.' Subsequently, she received rave reviews for her performance in the Encores! Off-Center production of THE CRADLE WILL ROCK.

A graduate of the renowned Yale School of Drama, Da'Vine has also studied classical voice and opera. She resides in Los Angeles.

## GIGI ZUMBADO (ZOE)

Gigi Zumbado is a Miami, Florida native who has been captivating audiences since childhood. Her early passion for music led her to excel as a skilled drummer, and she developed her talent as a dancer during her teenage years. Her acting career took off when she accompanied her sister to an audition in Atlanta, where she landed her first supporting role in Universal's smash hit PITCH PERFECT. After moving to Los Angeles, Gigi continued to build her career in both film and television, with appearances in Starz's HIGH TOWN and FOX's FANTASY ISLAND. She will next be seen in Ryan Murphy's upcoming ABC series DOCTOR ODYSSEY. In film, Gigi recently completed the Spyglass feature HEART EYES where she stars alongside Mason Gooding and Olivia Holt. She also wrapped the action-comedy BRIDE HARD opposite Rebel Wilson, Da'Vine Joy Randolph, Anna Camp, and Anna Chlumsky. Now residing in Los Angeles, Gigi remains a devoted Miami Dolphins fan and enjoys spending time with her friends and family.

## STEPHEN DORFF (KURT)

Stephen Dorff was born in Atlanta, Georgia, to Nancy and Steve Dorff, a composer. Chosen from over 2000 young men from around the world, he auditioned and won the coveted role of "PK" in John G. Avildsen's The Power of One in 1992, starring opposite Morgan Freeman, John Gielgud and Fay Masterson. For his performance, he was awarded the Male Star of Tomorrow Award from the National Association of Theater Owners. Dorff then amassed an impressive list of screen credits, chief among them New Line's Blade (1998), in which he starred opposite Wesley Snipes and won the "Best Villain" at both the MTV Movie and Blockbuster Entertainment Awards. He also co-starred with Susan Sarandon in HBO's Earthly Possessions (1999), based on Anne Tyler's novel about an unlikely romance between a young, fumbling bank robber and his hostage. He also starred in Scott Kalvert's street gang drama, Deuces Wild (2002), for MGM and as the champion of bad cinema in the John Waters comedy, Cecil B. DeMented (2000), co-starring Melanie Griffith. Additional credits include Entropy (1999), Blood and Wine (1996) with Jack Nicholson, and opposite Harvey Keitel in City of Industry (1997). He starred as the fifth Beatle, Stuart Sutcliffe, in Iain Softley's Backbeat (1994), and as the notorious Candy Darling in I Shot Andy Warhol (1996). His 2000s credits include Oliver Stone's World Trade Center (2006), Robert Ludlum's Covert One: The Hades Factor (2006), .45 (2006) with Milla Jovovich, Shadowboxer (2005) with Cuba Gooding Jr. and Helen Mirren, and the Disney thriller, Cold Creek Manor (2003), with Dennis Quaid and Sharon Stone for director Mike Figgis. Stephen appeared as disillusioned Hollywood actor and single father Johnny Marco in Sofia Coppola's Somewhere (2010), which won a Golden Lion at the 2010 Venice Film Festival. In 2009, Dorff teamed with Somewhere producer G. Mac Brown on Michael Mann's gangster drama Public Enemies (2009), starring opposite Johnny Depp and Christian Bale. Other credits include Texas Chainsaw Massacre prequel Leatherface (2017), David Gleeson's Don't Go (2018) alongside Melissa George, Nick Sarkisov's MMA drama "Embattled", Season 3 of True

Detective opposite Oscar-winner Maherasha Ali for HBO and Old Henry, an American Western film written and directed by Patsy Ponciroli. He starred in Divinity, the latest collaboration between Steven Soderbergh and Eddie Alcazar. Most recently he can be seen in HBO's Righteous Gemstones.

## JUSTIN HARTLEY (CHRIS)

Justin Hartley is an award winning actor, producer, and director most recently seen starring in the sixth and final season of NBC's critically acclaimed, award-winning series "This Is Us" opposite Mandy Moore, Milo Ventimiglia, Sterling K. Brown and Chrissy Metz. Created by Dan Fogelman, "This Is Us" earned over 234 award nominations and 55 wins since its debut in 2016. The heartwarming, emotionally provocative drama followed a unique set of triplets and their parents, whose lives and struggles intertwine, challenging the everyday presumptions about the people you think you know. Hartley's performance as Kevin Pearson, one-third of the "big three," garnered multiple Critics Choice Award nominations for Best Supporting Actor in a Drama Series (2019, 2020, 2021). He was most recently nominated for a 2022 Hollywood Critics Association Award for Best Supporting Actor in a Broadcast Network or Cable Series, Drama. Additionally, Hartley and his cast members won back-to-back SAG Awards for Outstanding Performance by an Ensemble in a Drama Series in both 2018 and 2019. Hartley brought his directorial skills to the table while on the show, helming one of the most heartfelt and emotional episodes to date: episode 413 "–A Hell of a Week: Part Three." Next up: Hartley will executive produce and star in "Tracker" for CBS. The series is an adaptation of Jeffrey Deaver's bestselling novel, "The Never Game," which follows lone-wolf survivalist Colter Shaw (Hartley) who roams the country as a "reward seeker," using his expert tracking skills to help private citizens and law enforcement solve all manner of mysteries while contending with his own fractured family.

In July 2022 it was announced that Hartley would lend his voice to the upcoming Spotify/DC/Warner Bros. podcast 'Harley Quinn & The Joker: Sound Mind 'starring as Batman opposite Christina Ricci (Harley Quinn) and Billy Magnussen (The Joker). The series, which has begun production, was developed by "Homecoming" writer and executive producer Eli Horowitz and tells the story of Gotham villain Harley Quinn from her perspective. As a producer, Hartley has been hard at work behind the scenes on multiple projects through his production company, ChangeUp Productions which inked an overall pod deal with 20th Television in 2019. Hartley and ChangeUp Productions recently sold a script commitment with penalty to ABC for their drama series, "No Good Deed," featuring writer Jeannine Renshaw ("Manifest," "Grey's Anatomy") and director Nzingha Stewart ("From Scratch"), which Renshaw, Stewart and Hartley will all executive produce. In film Hartley appeared in Netflix's hit comedy feature "Senior Year" alongside Rebel Wilson, Alicia Silverstone, and Sam Richardson. Additional credits for Hartley include: indie "A Lot of Nothing" opposite Y'lan Noel and Cleopatra Coleman, "The Hunt" and "Little" for Universal Pictures, "A Bad Moms Christmas" (STX Entertainment), "Another Time," which he also executive produced, and "Spring Breakdown," opposite Amy Poehler and Seth Meyers.

Born in Knoxville, IL, and raised in Orland Park, IL, Hartley had a love for bringing characters to life at an early age and began to take acting seriously once he got to college. He attended Southern Illinois University Carbondale and University of Illinois at Chicago, majoring in history and theatre. Upon graduation, he decided to make the move to Los Angeles, packing up his truck with no money or a job to give the entertainment industry a shot. In 2002, Hartley landed his first regular gig on the daytime soap "Passions," a role he held until 2006. He went on to star as billionaire Oliver Queen (the Green Arrow) on the long running, hit CW series "Smallville."

Once “Smallville” came to an end, Hartley went on to appear on a handful of hit series including: “Chuck,” “Castle,” and “Hart of Dixie.” In 2012, he returned to The CW as a series regular on the medical drama “Emily Owens, M.D.,” opposite Mamie Gummer. Throughout 2013-16, Hartley juggled a handful of TV projects, appearing on 12 episodes of ABC’s “Revenge,” 16 episodes of ABC’s summertime drama “Mistresses,” and taking over the role of Adam Newman in the infamous CBS soap opera “The Young and the Restless.” Hartley was nominated for a 2016 Daytime Emmy Award for Lead Actor in a Drama Series for his work on the show. While filming “Y&R,” it was announced that Hartley would be joining the cast of NBC’s fall 2016 passion project, “This Is Us.” As an entrepreneur, Hartley is a co-owner of Revel Spirits, trailblazing a new path in the world of agave spirits. Revel Spirits recently introduced a completely new Agave category called Avila, one that joins the likes of tequila, Mezcal, Sotol and Bacanora. On the charity front Hartley is active in multiple organizations that support animal rescue across the nation, and serves on the board of Operation Therapy, a charity that aligns veterans with trained service animals. He is an avid sports fan, and his favorite teams include the Los Angeles Dodgers, the Chicago Cubs, and the Chicago Bears. He also loves to travel and spend time with his wife, his 17-year-old daughter and their two dogs, Paisley and Alice.

## ABOUT THE FILMMAKERS

### SIMON WEST (DIRECTOR)

Simon West is a British film director and producer. His films include “CON AIR” starring Nicholas Cage, “THE GENERAL'S DAUGHTER” starring John Travolta and “LARA CROFT: TOMB RAIDER” starring Angelina Jolie. West is the only live action director ever whose first three 3 films all grossed over \$100m at the US box office. West also served as an executive producer on the Oscar nominated “BLACK HAWK DOWN”. With over 20 years in the entertainment industry, Joel David Moore is an accomplished actor, director, producer and writer across both film and television.
